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159th International Exhibition of Photography 2023

Chairman's Introduction.

I'm pleased to report that we have had a good increase in submissions this year. although not back to our pre-2020 levels. The number of entrants and entries each increased by around 50%. It was also great to see entrants from a broader range of countries, up from 22 last year to 28 this year. Most entries come from UK entrants and as a consequence so too does the number of acceptances. Last year's overall acceptance percentage was high for us due to the low entry. Edinburgh is one of the few Exhibitions that displays all of the accepted images. Last year we displayed 162 images, an acceptance percentage of 18%.

This year we have accepted 163 images and the percentage has fallen to just over 12%.

If you achieved an acceptance then you should be very proud. Getting an acceptance at Edinburgh is difficult and sought after.

Many thanks to our experienced selectors Libby Smith, David Lowe and Chris Hinterobermaier who all did a fine job producing a balanced exhibition from a broad range of genres and styles. As you walk round and chose your favourites, I hope that most of you will agree there is



variety and quality in the resulting exhibition.

To all who entered, thank you for taking the time to do so. For some entrants who travelled in hope, lack of an acceptance will have come as a disappointment. Many very good images have to be left behind. On a different day you may well have had a different outcome. I look forward to seeing your entries again next year for the **160**th **Edinburgh International**. It is your work and enthusiasm that makes the Exhibition a success.

My thanks also to all helpers behind the scenes and for the support from Edinburgh

Photographic Society members whose time and effort is given to make the Salon work. Without them it just wouldn't happen.

Our members enjoy opening the packages and seeing the variety of work entered. Then selection day and the logistics of bringing the prints to the selectors and scoring the images, allocating the awards, notifying the entrants, cataloguing and hanging the resulting exhibition. The fun continues when the exhibition opens and members welcome entrants and visitors from home and abroad. There are acquaintances to be made and to be renewed. There's always some discussion, likes and dislikes and that's part of what makes photography and the camaraderie of the photographic community fun. We look forward to your visit.

Despite inflationary pressures we reduced our entry fees this year, mainly as a recognition that postage and printing add significantly to the overall cost of entry. Digital is quick, easy and cheap to send round the world but the quality and aesthetic of a good print can't be beaten!

Libby Smith MPAGB, EFIAP, HonPAGB, Hon SPF (Scotland)

Libby's love of art and photography while at school became a passion, particularly for printing, firstly in the darkroom but then digitally, when she was to discover a new passion, Photoshop! This has resulted in her producing an eclectic mix of subjects and styles, gaining numerous awards and acceptances. Combining her love of Printing and Photoshop she has been a Lecturer, workshop trainer and Ambassador for Permajet for many years.

A member of Carluke Camera Club, Libby has been actively involved with Internationals and Club photography as a Judge, administrator, and exhibitor for 30 years. For most of that time, Libby has been involved in running the Scottish Photographic Federation, and The Scottish International Salon, including as President and Salon Chair. In 2005 she joined the Photographic Alliance of Great Britain committee. Libby was greatly honoured in 2007 to be made the first SPF Honorary Life Vice-President, and to be awarded the JS Lancaster medal by the PAGB in 2016.

Almost as much as creating images and taking photographs, Libby enjoys looking at images and meeting people within the photographic community. Consequently judging, lecturing, running Photoshop or printing workshops, working at, or organising some photographic event or another, is now a way of life.

David Lowe ARPS EFIAP DPAGB (England)

David first got interested in photography while at school. His love for photography began when a science teacher showed him a black and white print emerging in the tray. The interest turned into a passion and for the last 50 years he has been taking pictures of all sorts of subjects. David joined the Smethwick Photographic Society in 1976 and has been President twice. He is a proud member of the London Salon of Photography, having been invited to become a member in 2010 and was elected as Chairman for the period 2013-2015. David is an avid printer and likes to compete in competitions at club and international levels. He has won numerous National and International awards for his work including several coveted London Salon Medals. A keen and active sports photographer, David's images are made available to the media, event publicity and competitors.

Chris Hinterobermaier EFIAP (Austria)

Chris has over 700 International awards and is 5 times Austrian Champion.

He is the founder and former chairman of the world's largest photography salon the Trierenberg Super Circuit, to be replaced later this year by the new Motiva Photo Art Circuit (https://www.photocontest.at). Chris is also Chairman of the internationally famous AL-Thani Award for Photography.

His photographs have been exhibited in more than 75 exhibitions & galleries all over the world e.g. Amsterdam, Paris, London, New York, Berlin, and many more. His photography has been

published all over the world in photo magazines & books, on calendars, on television and the internet.

He has earned the titles of MFIAP and EFIAP/d3, accredited by the International Federation of Photographic Art (FIAP), and received the award of Master of Photography (MPSA) from the Photographic Society of America (PSA). He has also been recognized by the Dutch Photographic Society (BMK) for his exceptional work.

Marcel van Balken is also a frequently invited and respected judge and FIAP Liaison Officer Netherlands, PSA Liaison Officer Netherlands and PSA Country Membership Director Netherlands.

The Edinburgh International Exhibition of Photography first run in 1861 is one of the few remaining photographic print-only exhibitions in the world.

Technology has changed printing dramatically from those early years. That's not to say that traditional darkroom or other legacy processes are gone. They still have an enthusiastic following and their own aesthetic.

However, most prints now received by the Edinburgh International have been captured on digital cameras. The principles remain the same - the image remains as an original capture by light focussed on to a light sensitive sensor instead of some chemically coated surface.

The resulting captures can be edited digitally in computer applications, the best known being Photoshop, before being printed in ink.


Various paper surfaces and materials are available to enhance the final printed image and an informed choice of paper can enhance that image giving a unique look and feel.

A good quality physical print viewed by reflected light and held in the hand has an aesthetic quality that transcends the sterile image displayed on an electronic screen. Many photographers today feel that an image isn't finished until it is printed.
